



## Instructions for Nominators

Applications for nominees must be submitted by March 1, 2024

- Be sure to keep a copy of all materials and information submitted for future reference.
- A completed nomination includes the following information from the nominee:
  - First Name, Last Name
  - Maiden Name (if applicable)
  - Email Address
  - City, State, Country
  - Phone Number
  - Phonetic Pronunciations of Nominee's name
  - Mizzou degrees and graduation years, with majors (if applicable) (Ex: BA '12 - Political Science, MA '15 - Journalism, JD '18):
  - Any additional non-Mizzou degrees and graduation years, with majors (if applicable) (Ex: University of Missouri-Kansas City, MBA '20)
  - Current Employer and Location
  - Current Job Title
  - Industry Type
  - Accomplishments since graduation
    - This can include (but is not limited to) professional work, civic work or continued education
  - Contributions to the Mizzou community
    - Please include examples of volunteer work or involvement, either from time as a student or alum.
  - Contributions to their local community since graduation

- Please include any examples of volunteer work or community service
- Any additional information worthy of consideration
  - This may include work, career or other accomplishments
- Resume/CV
- Professional Headshot
  - Please attach a professional headshot 1MB or larger; if selected, this photo will appear in Mizzou features, social media outlets, and website announcements) \*
- Additional Information (This information will not be visible to judges and will be used for creating award announcement materials if the candidate is selected – i.e., tagging the recipient on social media)
  - Pronouns
  - Social Media
    - Twitter handle
    - Instagram account
- When recipients have been selected, they will be notified via email. Nominators will be emailed after recipients have been notified.
- In the case that a nomination is not selected, the nominator will be notified by email.

**Eligibility:**

To be eligible for this award, applicants must meet specific criteria.

Candidates for the Mizzou R.A.H. Award must...

- Be 35 or younger as of December 31, 2024.
- Have at least one Mizzou degree; undergrad and graduate degrees are both eligible.
- Display exemplary professional achievements in their field.
- Demonstrate a commitment to volunteerism or civic service.
- Have a record of campus involvement, either as a student or through alumni engagement.

The following categories of people are NOT eligible to receive the Mizzou R.A.H. Award:

- 1) Current members of University of Missouri Board of Curators
- 2) Current members of the Mizzou Alumni Association Board of Directors

Civic of Professional Achievement:

The University of Missouri-Columbia reserves the following rights: (1) to independently verify that applicants meet all criteria; (2) reject an applicant for any reason; (3) modify requirements as needed without notification.
